Arrival/Dismissal

Please pull up to one of the drop off/pick up stations and help your child out of the car. Please wait by your car for one of the camp teachers to do greet your child. Please be prompt when picking up your child. We can only release your child to a person who is listed on the emergency contact form. If you need to add a person to the list during the camp day, please call us.

Withdrawal Policy

We ask that parents make changes to their camp weeks or notify us of withdrawals prior to April 15th, 2024. After April 15th, we don't honor withdrawals or schedule changes. The Country School relies on tuition only to maintain a financially stable program. Thank you for your understanding.

Sick Child Policy

The Country School is permitted to administer over-the-counter or prescription medication including EPI Pens and Benadryl (with a doctor's prescription & an individual emergency plan that is filled out by the parent). Please do not bring your child to camp if he/she has one or more of the following symptoms:

- A runny nose
- Diarrhea
- Vomited or has had a fever in the past 24 hours
- Has started antibiotics in the last 24 hours
- Coughing or difficulty breathing
- Undiagnosed rash
- A temperature over 100.4°

If your child has any medical conditions that the staff should be aware of, please contact the office prior to the beginning of camp.
